PRENEED PAYMENT PLAN

Monthly payments are available without interest or billing charges. Many families welcome this opportunity to have the cost completely paid in advance.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

The goods and services shown inside are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you may select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Price is important. **NO ONE SHOULD PAY MORE THAN IS NECESSARY FOR ANY SERVICE.** You can be assured that our charges are based actual expenses and that our total prices for funerals, cremations, markers and outer burial containers are very competitive. Even more important you receive courteous, personalized service from a staff dedicated to meeting your needs; people who will listen and make sure that every detail is followed to completion.

This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery property, obituaries, etc. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

NON-DECLINABLE SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTORS & STAFF\$1,220
 Our fee for the services of Funeral Director and staff includes, but is not limited to: Staff to respond to initial request for services; arrangement and conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation of necessary authorization and permits; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral; including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, i.e. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility, such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.
THIS FEE FOR OUR BASIC SERVICES WILL BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL COST OF THE FUNERAL ARRANGEMENT YOU SELECT. (THIS FEE IS ALREADY INCLUDED IN OUR CHARGES FOR IMMEDIATE BURIALS AND FORWARDING OR RECEIVING REMAINS.)

TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO FUNERAL HOME within a radius of thirty miles..... \$415
 After normal business hours, weekends, or holidays add \$75.00. If more than one person is required, add an additional \$25.00. (Outside 30 mile radius, \$3.00 per mile)

EMBALMING.....\$510
 Except in certain special cases embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing, if you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

DIRECT CREMATION SERVICES

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). Direct cremation services do not include a funeral ceremony.

OTHER SERVICES

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME.....\$1,775
 This charge includes transfer of remains to funeral home & to airport, embalming, professional services, minimum transportation container (Does NOT include viewing, funeral ceremony or air fare)

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME\$1,375
 This charge includes professional services, transfer of remains to funeral home, and hearse to cemetery. (Does NOT include viewing or ceremony).

CASKETS AND OUTER BURIAL CONTAINERS
 If you arrange for a service that includes a casket, you may select from a group of caskets on display at our facility. Price is determined by composition. The least expensive caskets are particle board, usually with cloth covering. Metal caskets vary widely in price because of the thickness of the steel, quality of hardware and fabric used for the interior. Semi-precious metals, such as copper or bronze, cost more but offer greater protection for those who seek it. Hardwood caskets fall in a medium price range and their price is affected by the amount of hand finishing used to complete the product.
